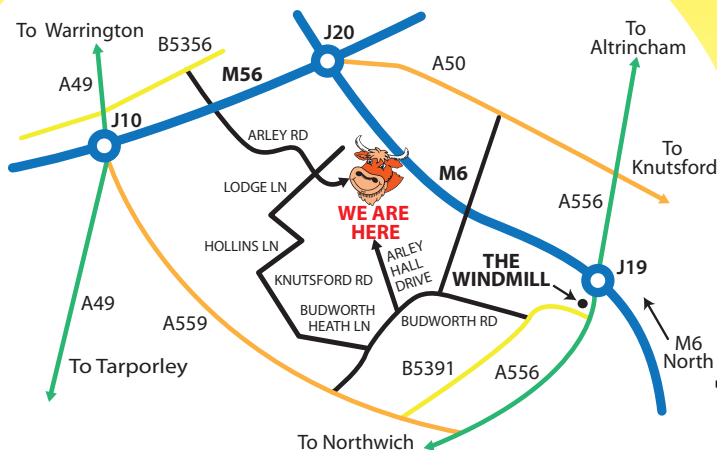
Additional Needs Groups
